Location

This regional appellation is produced in the village of «Saint-Aubin» renowned for the quality of its white wines.

The plot is situated on a hillside, beautifully exposed to the south-southwest, close to our vineyard Saint-Aubin «En Vesveau»

Terroir

Strong limestone dominant, light clays, sandy, very draining soil, subsoil limestone faulty allowing the plant to plunge deeply its roots and benefit from a regular freshness during the summer.

Our good farming practices allow us to be certified "High Environmental Value" and "Terra Vitis". Work soil by tillage, permanent grass cover and removing herbicides provide a biologically active soil life. The thinning and green harvesting help to control the yield and maintain good health of the plant by aeration clusters.

Winemaking

Traditional. Moderate pneumatic pressing. Static settlings for 12 hours then fermented in oak barrels (30%) and tanks during 12 months.

Tasting notes

This wine reveals a charming pale yellow colour with green reflections. On the nose, the floral aromas are delicately released with notes of hawthorn and apple. The ample mouth reveals fresh almond notes with a nice tension on the finish.
